



## Test Internet Connection Speeds

This process will test how fast your computer can communicate over the Internet.

1. Browse to the internet site: <http://www.speakeasy.net/speedtest/>
  - a. You may be able to click on the above link
  - b. If not, copy the link into your Internet browser address bar and Click on “Go”
2. You may be asked to download and install or to update Macromedia Flash Player. If asked, you will need to accept this request in order to use the tool.
3. Click on the city nearest you to begin the test

Two speeds will be reported: Upload and Download.

- **Download Speed** reflects how fast you can download data to your computer from sites on the Internet.
- **Upload Speed** reflects how fast you can send data from your computer out over the Internet.

Typical Speeds:

- Dial-up: 28-56 kbps
- Cable/DSL (often referred to as high speed): 128 kbps – 1500 kbps (1.5 Mbps)
